HomeKit is a scheme run by Bath Share and Repair to provide electrical items to people in BANES who are in need for example, because of coming out of homelessness and setting up home or because of the economic situation. The idea is that small household electrical items, in reasonable condition, are donated by people who no longer need them. These are then checked for safety and generally refurbished by the repair team at Share and Repair, before being made available via care agencies in the area to people who can use them but can't afford them.
