Ukraine Crisis

As the crisis in Ukraine continues into the second week, please pray for the people of Ukraine and their country. Please pray for all those who are afraid, that the everlasting arms of God hold them in this time of great fear. Please also pray for the people and leaders of Russia, and leaders from around the world, that they can work together to bring a swift resolution to the conflict and bring peace for Ukraine.

All We Can and the Methodist Church in Britain have launched an emergency appeal in response to events unfolding in Ukraine. As communities face violence, upheaval, and the trauma of war, your urgent support is needed. Working together with the Global Relationships Team of the Methodist Church in Britain, donations will be used to support the response to the crisis happening in Ukraine, and ensure that critical humanitarian assistance is available to those who need it.

We will be having a collection over the next few weeks for the crisis, via All We Can. Katie Chun will be giving out slips on Sunday about how to make donations via post or online, and we hope to have some envelopes soon (they are on their way) for cash donations, that can have gift aid added to them.

Children and Family Worker

Many of us enjoyed watching Julie's summary of her work in the service a few weeks ago, we hope that you will all agree that Julie has been doing a fantastic job as our Children and Family Worker. It has been great to see the growth in the areas and groups that she has been involved with, not just in numbers but, more importantly, in faith. Julie and her teams have worked creatively to maintain contact with young families despite lockdown and we thank God for all that they have done. Please continue to pray for all those involved in Seeds, Messy Church, Lighthouse and the Harbour, in particular.

Julie's post has been funded up to now by a mixture of grants from the Methodist Bristol District and the North east Somerset and Bath Circuit and our own church giving. The district will only fund a post for 5 years so that is finishing this year which will leave us with a £3500 shortfall from September.

We are applying for money from various grant-making trusts to help fund the Children and Family Worker post next year but would be grateful if you could prayerfully consider giving a contribution to this. Any money that is given by a tax payer can be increased by 25% by gift-aiding it. Please talk to a steward if you need any more information or want to get involved either prayerfully or practically.
