Christian Aid and Climate Justice

As reported in the last notices, Christian Aid is campaigning for a New Deal for Climate Justice which looks to reduce our reliance on fossil fuels but also to do so in a way that lifts up the world's poor. This is particularly important in the run up to the UN Climate Conference in Britain in 2021.

Christian Aid have produced a card that asks you to do two things - to pray regularly for a fair Climate Deal and also to send a card to the Prime Minister asking the government to take five actions. Ian Souter still has a number of these cards left and will bring them with him on his pastoral walks. Please ask for one when you see Ian.
