Easing of Covid Restrictions

With the easing of Covid restrictions, it is easy to get excited about 'returning to normal.' However, because of the current high cases of Covid, it is important that we adopt a cautious, phased return so people feel safe when they come to Church for worship. Therefore, **from Sunday 25**th **July** we will work with the following guidelines:

- 1. Continue to use Track and Trace
- 2. Continue to use hand gel when entering Church
- 3. Continue to wear face coverings when moving around Church and only to remove them when sat down
- 4. We will be allowed to sing!! To begin with, however, masks should be worn when singing
- 5. Leave one seat between congregation members (unless in same family/bubble etc)

We will review procedures regularly, either tightening or relaxing as required!
