Same Sex Marriage

Following the decision of the Methodist Conference to allow churches to decide whether to allow same sex marriages, the Church Council will meet in November to consider its decision.

On **Monday 1**st **November at 7:30pm** Ian Souter will be giving some background to the journey the Methodist Church has been on over many years regarding human sexuality and will also provide some Biblical background which you may find helpful in formulating your own views on this matter.

There will also be an open meeting on **Sunday 7th November at 3pm** for all who are a part of the worshipping community to express their views on this matter. This will be an exercise in listening to one another and will help the Church Council come to its decision.
